INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRESENTERS

The following guidelines will help you gear up for the presentation.

Please provide an abstract of your research study by **March 10th, 2024**. The abstract should include title of the study, authors and affiliation, background, aim and objectives of the study, methodology used, results, discussion and conclusion.

Since this conference is dedicated solely for the purpose of Autism awareness, we encourage the participants to present studies related to autism in children alone. The word limit should not exceed 300 words (excluding references). You may send more than one abstract.

The abstracts that have been approved by the scientific committee will be communicated to the respective presenters well in advance.

ABOUT THE PRESENTATION

- The presentation will take place from **7.30 – 8:30 am on March 24, 2024**.
- Participants may come directly to the venue for the presentation.
- Preferably, one, or maximum two authors will be allowed to present their study together.
- Duration of **3 minutes** would be provided for each presentation. Please do not exceed the time limit.
- Please email your final PPTs to autconconference@gmail.com by **March 20, 2024**.
- This will reduce last-minute hassles.
- The technical team will project the slides for each presenter. The exact order of presenters will be shared with you on March 24, 2024.

GUIDELINES TO PREPARE PPTs

- Ensure that you prepare only 6 slides (max).
- Use Times New Roman font with a font size of 24 in the slides. Ensure that the graphs/tables are readable.
- The header should have the name of the conference – **8th Annual NICE Conference on AUTISM**
- The slides need to cover the following domains:
 1. Title of the study, Authors, and their affiliations
 2. Aim and objective of the study
 3. Methodology
 4. Results & Discussion
 5. Conclusion

Top three winners will be selected to receive the rewards during the Valedictory.
